



Study the steps and read the dialogue below. Answer the questions that follow.

	<p>Prepare a paper plate of suitable size, some cotton balls, glue, scissors, utility knife, staple and elastic straps. Children should request for an adult assistance in using the utility knife.</p>
	<p>First, cut out the inner circle of the paper plate with the utility knife and put aside the cut out inner circle. Now you have a nice ring for the next step.</p>
	<p>Next, stick cotton balls on the paper ring and leave to dry for a few hours. Keep in mind not to use too much glue while sticking the cotton balls as it might take longer for your mask to dry.</p>
	<p>Once it is dry, cut out lamb ear shapes from the inner circle that you have kept aside. Stick the ears on the back of the mask.</p>
	<p>Lastly, attach the elastic straps using the staple. Your lamb mask is ready for a fun activity.</p>
